Dear Mr. Hilton:
At theix meeting on Septenker 15, 2008, the Brunswick Town Council vopod umaninously in support of the reclaseiflcation of the Androacogoin River from the Durham Boat launch or Worumho Dar to ite mouth at Nertymeecting Bay, fxem Class \& to Clasa 日, as set forth in the petition of the Friends of Merrymeeting Bay \{Form).
Reclaselfication will result in the mainteramce of Class B stanAards, which FOMB data cleasily show are presentiy belng met in this section of the river. Hectassification will psovide the river with increaged grotection against degradation in the future. Which wil enable its conditian to continue to improve.

As you know, classification upgraties are appropriate where it is egcially or ecologically desirable to attain higher standards and when the technologieal and financial capacity exists to achteve those higher standards wichin a feanonable time. Becauno the river already meets Class g standarde ti,e., it is elearly technologically and financially feasible to meet them, and because there is also clear social and ecological benefit frcm a cleaner river, the reguested claesification La appropriate.
The experience of other commanities around the ration has shown time and again the tremendour potential for social, rocreational, envirammental and aconomic benefit from river restoratione.

Therefore, on bahalf of the trunsulck Town council, we implore the Board of Envirammental protection to approve the reclassification of the Andrascoggin River below Lewiaton/juburn to claas 日, at yout meeting now scheasled for September 18, 2006.
